With proper care, your appliance will ensure a brighter smile.

- Soak in water or denture cleanser when not in use to maintain pliability, shape, and to prevent drying.
- Clean daily with a soft-bristle toothbrush and mild toothpaste, soap or dishwashing liquid.
- Staining may occur from some foods.
 Use over-the-counter denture cleansers to remove stains.
- Handle with care to avoid drops.
- Commercial denture cleansers for removable appliances come as tablets, creams, pastes, gels, and solutions. Follow manufacturer instructions after rinsing away food particles and removing denture adhesive.
- Avoid hot water to prevent warping.
- Do not chew ice or bones while wearing dentures.
- Never use bleach, abrasive toothpaste, non-denture-specific cleaners, or a stiff brush as they can damage the appliance.
- Do not soak in alcohol-based liquids (e.g., Listerine). These may cause irritation.
- Do not use denture cleansers while the appliance is in your mouth.
- For fixed implant dentures, contact your dentist for cleaning and maintenance.

Contact your dentist if there are changes to your bite, or if the denture feels loose.
